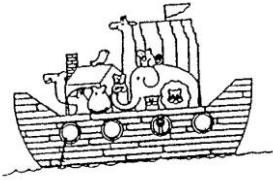


ANIMAL CRACKERS NURSERY SCHOOL
PART TIME NURSERY SCHOOL - 8:30-11:00
SAMPLE DAILY SCHEDULE

- 8:30-8:40 **Arrival/Drop off:** Greet families and children individually. Conduct health check. Wash hands and sign in. Guide children in selecting from activity choices.
- 8:40-9:00 **Classroom based activities**
- 9:00-9:10 **First Circle:** Lead children in singing/ fingerplays, discussion of the days plan, interactive calendar, weather, helper assignments.
- 9:10-9:55 **Activity Time – Mixed Age Group:** Guide children in selecting interest areas. Lead group activity that builds on children’s skills and interests. Work with children engaged in play. Observe and interact with individual children to extend play and learning.
- 9:55-10:05 **DEAR Time (Drop Everything and Read)** Children rejoin their group and choose from a selection of books, quiet games.
- 10:05-10:25 **Outdoor Play:** Supervise the playground equipment and materials. Observe and interact with children as they play. Extend themes outdoors, if appropriate. Help children to put away or carry in toys and materials, hang up jackets, toilet and wash up.
- 10:25-10:40 **Wash/Snack Time/puzzles:** Wash hands. Sit with children and enjoy a snack together. Reflect on the day encouraging conversation. Puzzle time as children finish snack.
- 10:40-10:55 **Second Circle:** Music and Movement. Read and discuss a storybook or flannel story. Use props to help children retell and interact with the book.
- 10:55-11:00 **Dismissal:** Jackets and backpacks on. Goodbye ritual established by individual teacher.

SAMPLE DAILY SCHEDULE

- 12:00-12:10 **Arrival/Drop Off:** Greet families and children individually. Conduct health check. Wash hands and sign in. Guide children in selecting from activity choices.
- 12:10-12:30 **Classroom based activities**
- 12:30-12:45 **First Circle:** Lead children in singing/ fingerplays, discussion of the days plan, interactive calendar, weather, helper assignments.
- 12:45-1:30 **Activity Time – Mixed Age Group:** Guide children in selecting interest areas. Lead group activity that builds on children’s skills and interests. Work with children engaged in play. Observe and interact with individual children to extend play and learning.
- 1:30-1:40 **DEAR Time (Drop Everything and Read)** Children rejoin their group and choose from a selection of books, quiet games.
- 1:40-2:10 **Outdoor Play:** Supervise the playground equipment and materials. Observe and interact with children as they play. Extend themes outdoors, if appropriate. Help children to put away or carry in toys and materials, hang up jackets, toilet and wash up.
- 2:10-2:30 **Wash/Snack Time/puzzles:** Wash hands. Sit with children and enjoy a snack together. Reflect on the day encouraging conversation. Puzzle time as children finish snack.
- 2:30-2:55 **Second Circle:** Music and Movement. Read and discuss a storybook or flannel story. Use props to help children retell and interact with the book.
- 2:55-3:00 **Dismissal:** Jackets and backpacks on. Goodbye ritual established by individual teacher.
